During the school closure, resources were created to provide guidelines for supporting students through virtual learning and to ensure privacy compliance when hosting School Team Meetings. These resources have been revised to provide guidelines and to ensure continued privacy for hosting virtual meetings and supporting remote learning, regardless of the status of school operations. As noted in the documents, Teams is the platform that is supported by DCDSB and should be used for all meetings. These guidelines apply to any approved place of work which may include: school, home or office location.

It is the expectation that these documents be used for every virtual school team meeting and considered when supporting students learning in a virtual environment.
