EWBT BOARD OF TRUSTEES: CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

May 1, 2017, the CUPE Education Workers' Benefits Trust was established to provide employee life, health and dental benefits to CUPE-represented education workers in over 110 bargaining units across Ontario, as well as potentially other employee groups in the education sector.

The EWBT is governed by a nine-member Board of Trustees, with five Trustees appointed by CUPE and four appointed by the Crown and school board trustee associations. The Board of Trustees will be responsible for the operational and financial sustainability of the EWBT, including design and adoption of the CUPE benefits plan and any later amendments, as well as validating the plan's ongoing sustainability; establishing and following EWBT policies, including funding and investment policies; selecting auditors, actuaries and other advisors or service providers; and identifying efficiencies that can be achieved in the EWBT's operation.

CUPE is seeking applications for one Trustee position, for an initial term of three years. This is a volunteer position for which all reasonable expenses will be reimbursed. Each individual Trustee must be over 18 years of age and a resident of Canada and must not be an undischarged bankrupt.

CUPE is seeking Trustees who represent the breadth and diversity of its membership and who will add value to the Board's discussions and decisions.

CUPE invites applications from members who are familiar with the unionized education sector in Ontario; have experience with and an understanding of employee benefits plans; are available to attend at least quarterly meetings; and are committed to providing high-quality benefits to CUPE members on a long-term, sustainable basis. Governance experience and bilingualism (French/English) are considered assets.
